Summer Camp Assistant

The Sandwich Park District is taking applications for one (1), 30 hour per week, seasonal Recreation Position. Under the direction of the Summer Camp Lead Counselor and Recreation Manager, this individual will assist in providing guidance and instruction to day camp participants through a variety of games, crafts, sports, and outdoor activities/programs.

Job duties include but are not limited to, organize, supervise, and conduct the districts day camp programs and activities as assigned. Plan and implement weekly schedules. Maintain and keep accurate program records including incident reports, attendance records/rosters, and other documentation required by the district. Ensures the program site is kept clean, organized, and free of litter. Communicates to the Recreation Manager any issues in the program, including schedule changes, program supplies/equipment needs, participant behavior issues, or other concerns and feedback.

While performing the duties of this job, the employee will be required to frequently walk, perform overhead work, bend stoop, and kneel. The employee must be able to lift, and carry up to 60 lbs. The employee will frequently drive and use recreational equipment and vehicles. This position is required to work both inside and outside depending on the assignment. Employees in this position may be exposed to inclement weather, heat, cold, rain, snow, etc.

Starting wage is \$15.00 per hour. This position must be able to work 8:30am-4:30pm Monday-Friday. There will be a structured lunch break in between camps. Camps are scheduled to start June 8th and will conclude July 24th. Counselors will not work the week of July 6th. Counselors will be expected to attend an orientation date prior to the beginning of camp on June 8th. Applicants must be 16 yrs. or older, and hold a valid driver's licenses, applicant must pass a standard background check. Applicants must be currently certified in CPR, AED and First Aid from an accredited organization or obtain certification through the Sandwich Park District within a reasonable amount of time.
